89 of 193 BOP facilities are over-capacity.

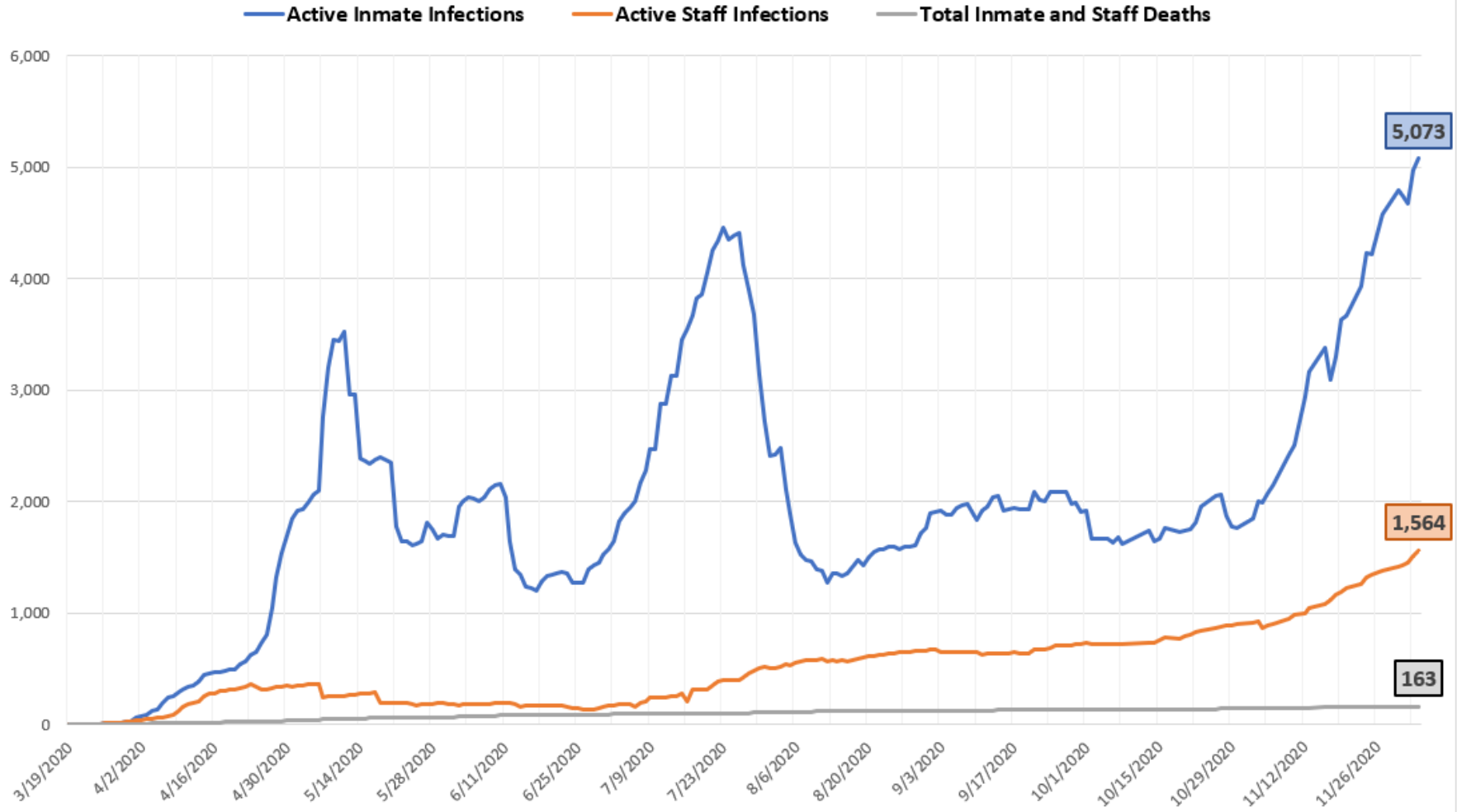
Overall average capacity: 97.6%

Active COVID-19 Infections and Deaths BOP and Private Prisons

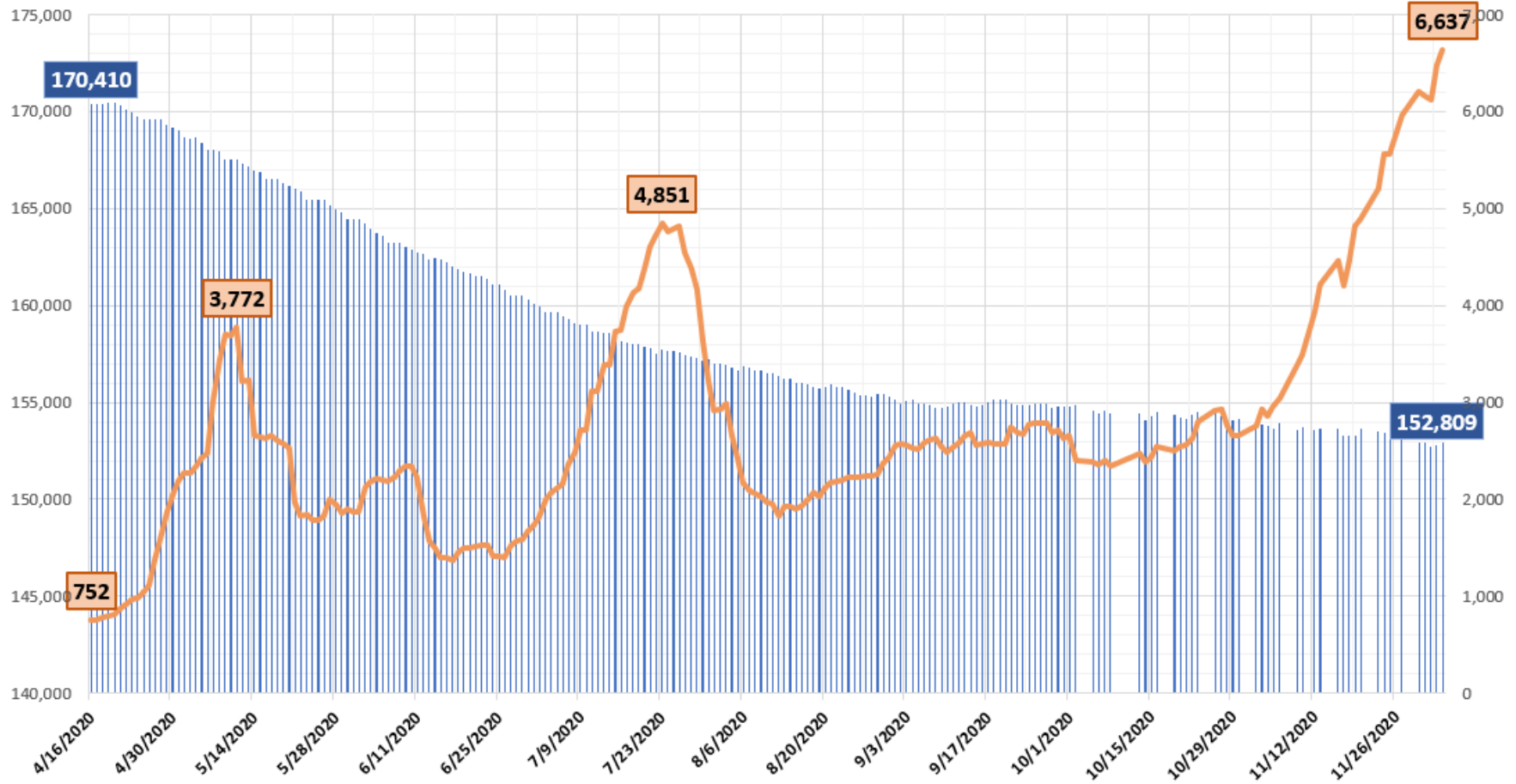

■ BOP Pop. (Left Axis) — Active Infected (Right Axis)



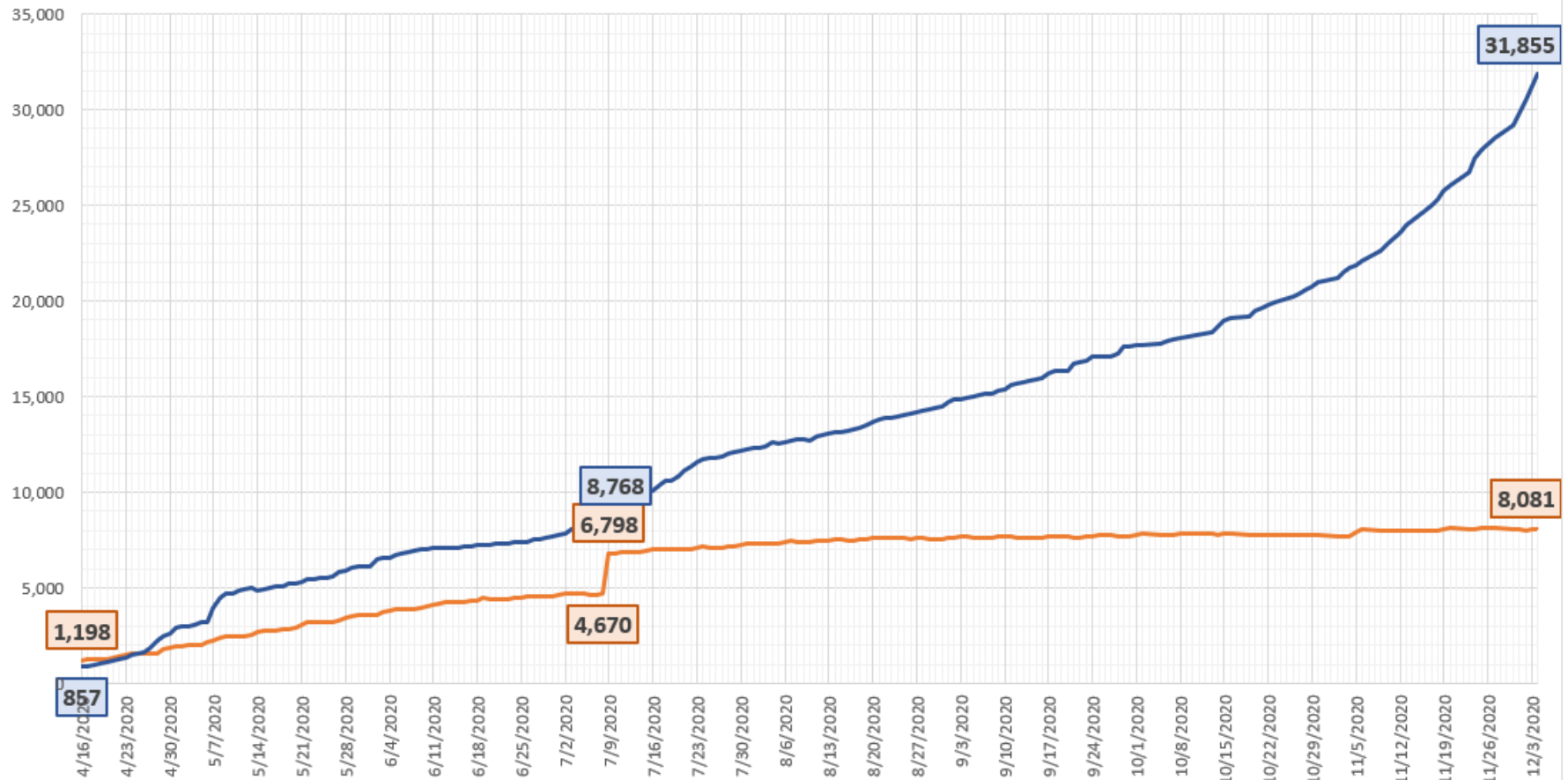


Cumulative Inmate and Staff Infections* Compared to BOP Placement on Home Confinement

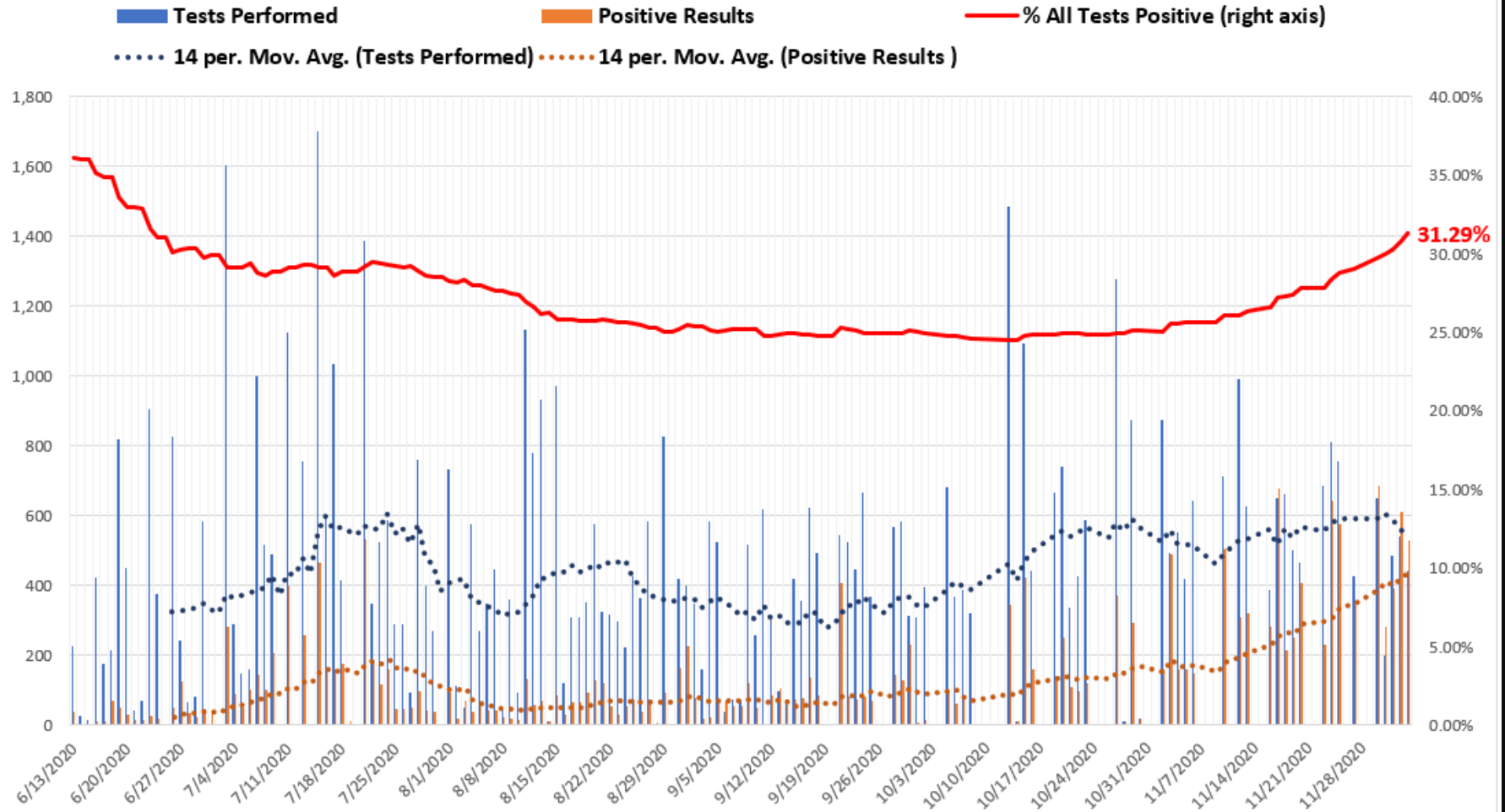
— BOP Placement on Home Confinement — Cumulative All Infections





Daily Tests and Positive Results with 14-Day Moving Average Trendline

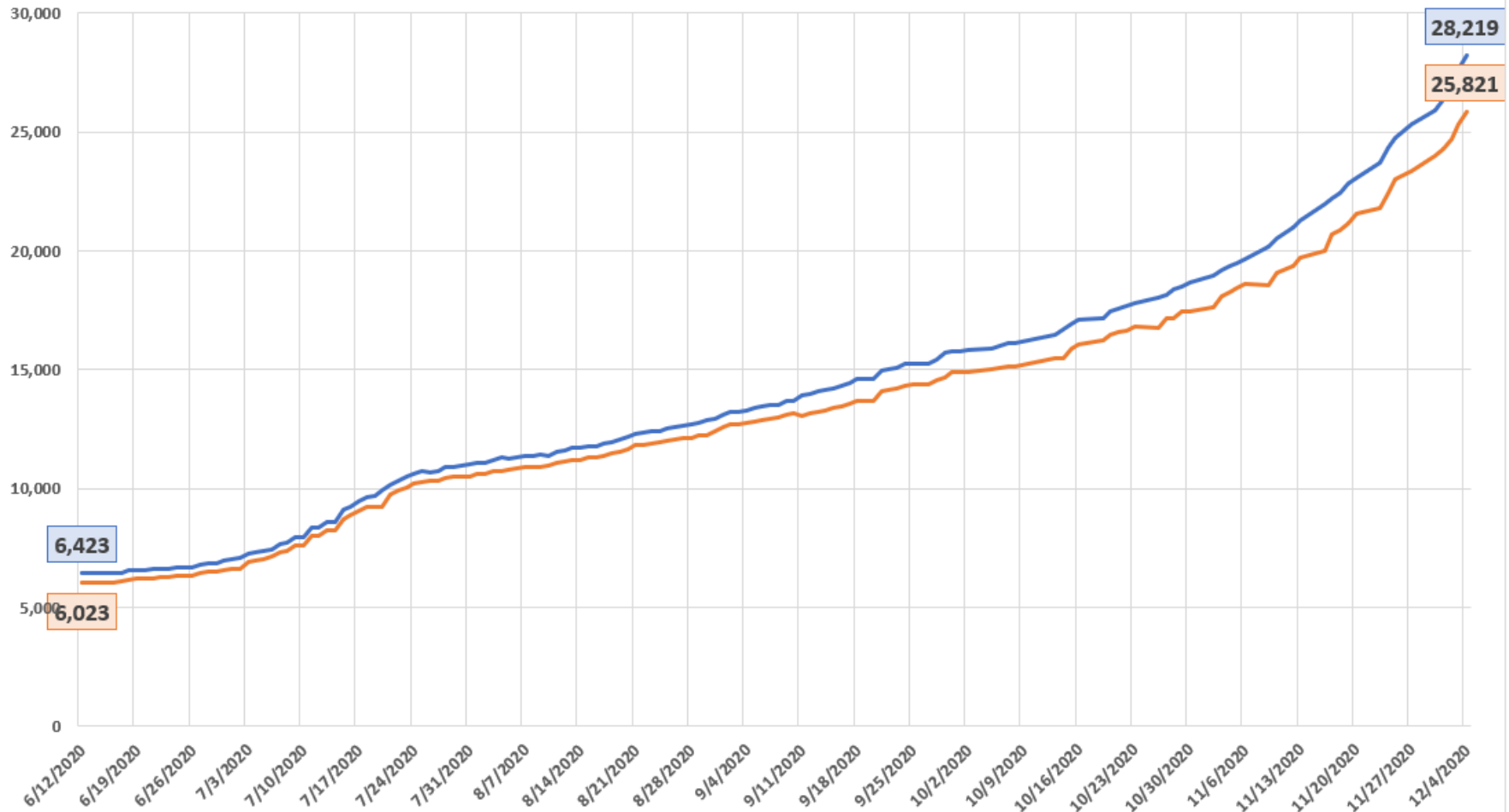
